List in his/her possession the day of Grand Parade. Driver may be required to check off and sign this Inspection List and present to Grand Parade Safety Officials inspecting floats.

Driver Safety Official

1. Driver has proper 180-degree forward vision (or radio communication).
2. Driver has proper ventilation.
3. Float driver has valid Driver License.
4. Engine is clean of excessive oil and grease residue.
5. Float/Truck has a UL approved, 3A 10BC 5 LB Fire Extinguisher (which has been serviced, tagged, and dated within one (1) year by a fire extinguisher company), within reach of the driver and at rear of float.
6. All decorative materials used are flame retardant.
7. Brakes are in good working order. Tires have been checked for legal tread depth. Float is properly serviced with gasoline, oil, and water.
8. Towed trailers or floats must have safety cables or chains in place and attached to tow unit; towing hooks, front and rear, are accessible and of sufficient strength for towing.
9. Exhaust pipe is free of leaks, extends at least twelve (12) inches beyond apron. Where pipe is within twelve (12) inches of apron, (any direction), pipe is to be protected by lagging.
10. Each standing float rider MUST have approved body support. Seated riders safety will be assessed by the float inspector.

The above inspection has been made and, to the best of our knowledge, this float is acceptable for participation in the Kent Cornucopia Days Grand Parade.
