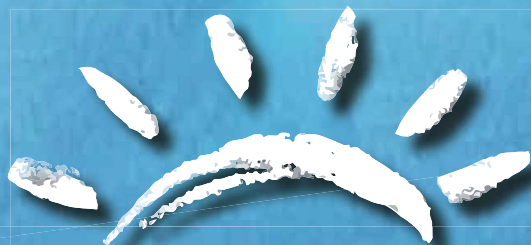

9. 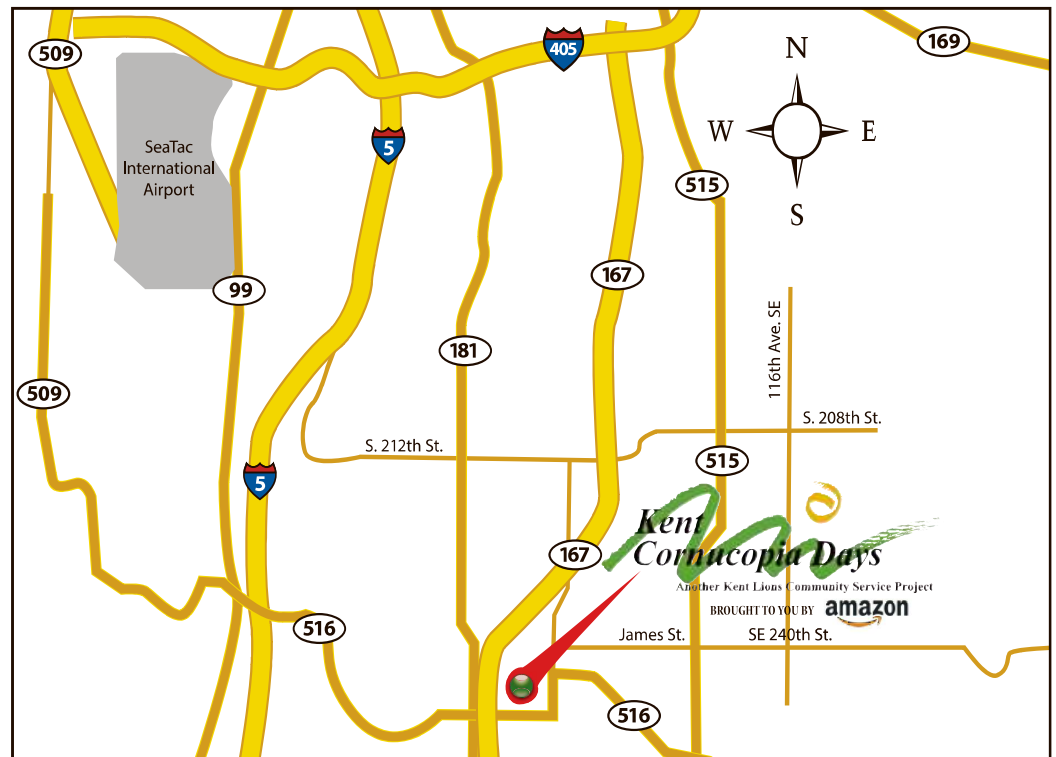
From the South:

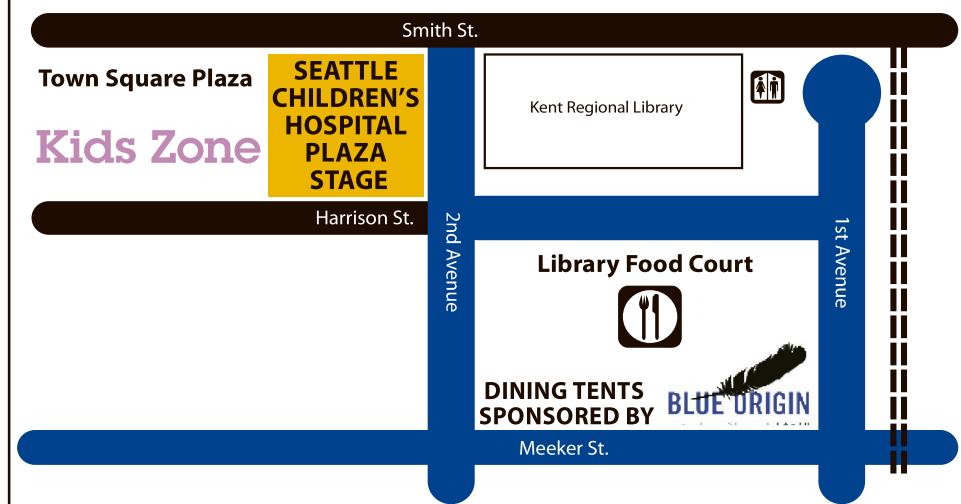
