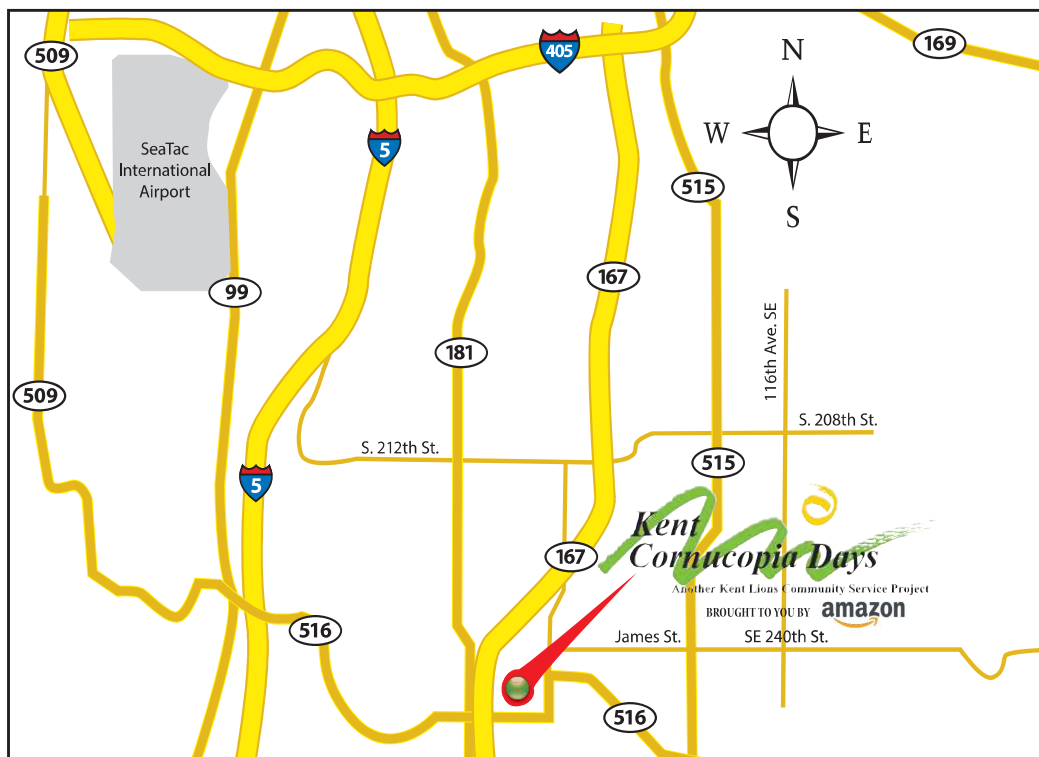
### From the South:

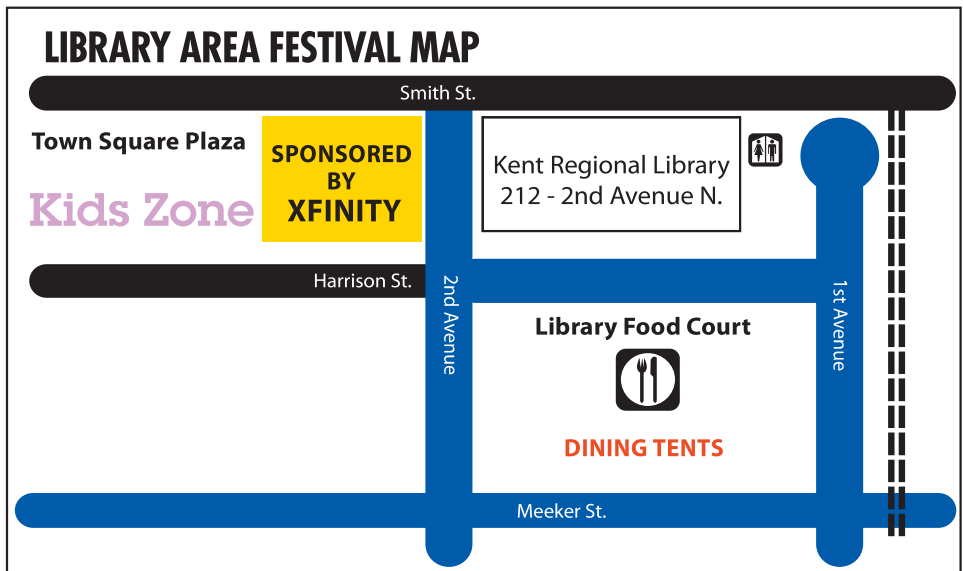
